

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Do 10 jumping jacks.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out eating a bowl of rice.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word "rice" in Japanese, which is "gohan." (Did you know Japan produces much of the world's rice supply?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Try to do a split.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out making a banana split.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Shout out the name of the country that invented banana splits. (Did you say USA?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Jump up and down twenty quick times.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out beating a drum.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word for the most well-known drum in Africa, which is "djembe." (Did you know drums are an important part of African culture?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Try to jump up and click your heels together.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out putting on a pair of boots.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Shout out which country is in the shape of a boot. (Did you say Italy?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Jog in place for twenty seconds.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out climbing a mountain.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word "Kilimanjaro." (Did you know Mt. Kilimanjaro is the tallest mountain in Africa?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Do a standing broad jump.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out being a kangaroo.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word for a baby kangaroo, which is "joey." (Did you know kangaroos live in the wild in Australia?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Do a running broad jump.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out doing a hula dance.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word for "hello" in Hawaiian, which is "aloha." (Did you know the hula dance started on the Hawaiian Islands?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Try to do five push-ups.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out putting on winter clothes.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word "cold" in Swedish, which is "kall." (Did you know the coldest continent on the earth is Antarctica?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Do ten sit-ups.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out being a giraffe.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word "giraffe" in Swahili, which is "twiga." (Did you know Swahili is spoken in Africa, where giraffes live in the wild?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Lean to the left for 10 seconds, then lean to the right for ten seconds.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out building the Leaning Tower of Pisa.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Shout out the name of the city where the Leaning Tower of Pisa is. (Did you say Pisa? It's a city in Italy, Europe.)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Give yourself some space and twirl around three times.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out playing soccer.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word for "soccer" in South America, which is "futbol." (Did you know soccer is played all over the world?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** March around for 30 seconds, pretending to play an instrument.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out catching a baseball.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word "baseball" in Korean, which is "yah-gu." (Did you know baseball is popular in North and South America, Japan, and South Korea, among other countries?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Do twenty arm circles.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out being a sloth.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word for "sloth" in Spanish, which is "perezoso." (Did you know sloths live in South America?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Try to stand on one foot for 30 seconds.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out building a tower.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say the word "tower" in Arabic, which is "burj." (Did you know the tower of Babel was built in Asia, possibly in the country of Iraq?)

**Physical Challenge (everyone):** Pretend to swim around for 20 seconds.

**Acting Challenge (one person):** Act out being a shark.

**Word Challenge (everyone):** Say "shark" in Indonesian, which is "hiu." (Did you know Indonesia is a nation made up of thousands of islands and is one of the main shark fisheries in the world?)

**Directions to Game Leader: Make sure teams know everyone does the physical challenges and word challenges, and only one person does the acting challenge, while the rest try to guess what he's doing. Teams can't move to the next spot until they complete each card. Photocopy these instructions, cut them into individual cards, and put a set of 15 in an envelope for each team.**
