

# Day 1: Small Group Time

Discuss some or all of the following questions from the Discussion sheet. Any day a Bible passage is mentioned, help them look it up and read it together, or have it bookmarked and read it to them.

1. **When we asked a little while ago what comes into your mind when you think of God, what did you think of?** Take responses.
2. **How do you think you got that idea about God?** Take responses. **Where should we go to learn about who God really is?** Take responses, and remind them we can't make God into who we want him to be, but we learn of who he truly is in the Bible.
3. **What is something you've learned so far today about God?** Take responses.
4. **Does God seem exciting to you? Worth knowing?** Take responses, and tell them how excited you are to share more this week about your awesome God. You may want to share your testimony here. Your enthusiasm about God will be inspiring.

# Day 3: Small Group Time

Discuss some or all of the following questions.

1. Can you think of any movies you've seen with a king sitting on a throne, wearing a robe? What do you picture God's robe to look like that is mentioned in Isaiah?
2. What is something about God you're amazed about today?
3. Do you ever sing songs to God? Do you like to? The Bible often tells us to sing our praises to God. Do you have any favorite songs you like to sing to God?
4. Let's try "popcorn prayers," which are short one-sentence prayers that "pop" up around the circle. Someone starts and praises God, "I praise you, God, for being loving." Then another person says one thing he praises God for, and another person says something she praises God for, and on and on.

Discuss some or all of the following questions.

1. Do you like to watch or read mysteries? Which ones? Have you ever read or watched a mystery where they were trying to figure out who the guilty party was?
2. For those who did the Clues option, did it surprise you to have to put yourself in the line-up of people who are guilty of sin? Do you understand why that's true?
3. Have you ever considered just how amazing it is that the wonderful, loving God came to earth for sinners like you, to rescue his loved ones from sin's punishment? Do you understand that you need to repent of your sins and trust in Jesus to have eternal life?
4. Have you ever admitted your sin to Jesus, believed in him, and forever received him as your Savior and Lord? Can you tell us about it? Take kids' testimonies here, or share your own.
