Day 1

- ☐ Light jackets for Bruce and Wayne
- ☐ Office chair
- ☐ 2 wingback chairs (pillows/throw optional)
- ☐ Alex's aquarium catalog (use AiG's *Aquarium Guide* [see catalog] or any magazine or catalog)
- ☐ Alex's small Bible
- ☐ Turtle's messenger bag with Visitor Information Packet (see NOTES below)
- ☐ Scuba-Cave Emergency Button
- ☐ Scuba-Man's Bible (for Alex)

Day 2

- ☐ Snorkel-Boy's Deception Detector (use a small tablet computer)
- ☐ Scuba-Sub (see Notes below)
- ☐ Jumper cables
- ☐ Electric eel (use a plush animal or make one with socks)
- ☐ Octopus's cell phone

NOTES

TURTLE'S VISITOR INFORMATION PACKET

Create a "Visitor Information Packet" by stocking a colored pocket folder with papers and pamphlets. Use a messenger bag to carry it in.

SCUBA-SUB

The Scuba-Sub can be constructed with large cardboard boxes and light wood framing. It should be large enough to accommodate 2 adult men and have sides short enough to step over without too much difficulty. Be creative and have fun with this. Paint it a fun color and add racing stripes, decals, battery-powered LED lights, a working hood, a rear spoiler, etc.

SCUBA-MAN'S UTILITY BELT

For the basic belt, use a strip of cardboard covered with duct tape with velcro at each end. Next, attach various travel size plastic pouches, tubes, and compartments. Then spray paint everything for a uniform glossy finish.

SNORKEL-BOY'S BACKPACK AND SUPPLIES

Use a standard school-type backpack (the larger the better). For supplies, include logical ones (rope, flashlight, batteries, powerbars, bandages, duct tape, etc.) along with the funny ones (toothbrush, nail clippers, small framed photo of Snorkel-Boy's mother, and his plush dog or cat "Fluffy").

GREAT WHITE'S SEA STAR "SHERIFF STAR"

Use a toy sea star or make one from corrugated cardboard. A velcro strip (hook side only) on the back should make it stick to Great White's costume.

"THE DOOR"

Use the center rear auditorium doors for this. To enhance the effect, set up bright white spotlights to shine through the doors into the auditorium as they open (along with the music effect). Also, if possible, avoid using these doors for any other purpose during the drama.
