Review Game Questions and Answers

1. **What is the name of the greatest book ever?**
The Bible!
2. **What was the earth like when God first created it?**
Answers may vary: Totally perfect, lots of beautiful trees, flowers, and cool animals. Very good.
3. **What was yesterday's lifeline verse?**
1 Corinthians 16:13: "Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong."
KJV: "Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong."
4. **Who was yesterday's animal pal?**
Hydro the Whale. (Hydro reminds us there's a whale of a problem.)
5. **Why did God destroy the earth with the Flood?**
The earth was corrupt and full of violence. God saw that everyone did evil all the time.
6. **Yes or No: Noah was a brave man.**
Yes. Noah bravely obeyed all God told him to do.
7. **Who told Noah to build the Ark?**
 - A. Jonah
 - B. Noah saw it in a dream
 - C. God
 - D. MosesC—God.
8. **Who is the animal pal today?**
Hammer the Shark. (Hammer reminds us to nail obedience.)
9. **What were some specific instructions God gave to Noah about building the Ark?**
God told Noah how big to build the Ark (as wide as two school buses put together, three stories high [3 giraffes] and longer than 1½ football fields).
10. **True or False—There were dinosaurs on the Ark.**
True. (God brought representatives of every kind of land animal [including dinosaurs] to the Ark. It could be that the dinosaurs on the Ark were younger and therefore smaller dinosaurs, instead of older, larger ones.)

Review Game Questions and Answers

1. Fill in the blank: Hammer the Shark reminds us to nail _____.

Hammer the Shark reminds us to nail obedience.

2. When God told Noah to build the Ark, did he do it:

- A. Right away
- B. When he felt like it
- C. After God asked him a few more times
- D. Never

A. Right away

3. Yes or No: Noah and his family were on the Ark for 1 day.

No. They were on the Ark for about one year.

4. What is today's lifeline verse?

Psalm 31:14: "I trust in You, O Lord."

KJV: "I trusted in thee, O Lord."

5. Yes or No: Did Noah obey God's commands?

Yes. (Genesis 6:22 says he obeyed all God commanded him to do.)

6. Did all the Flood water just come from rain above?

No, it didn't. The Bible says that it rained, but also that the fountains of the deep burst forth as well.

7. Who is today's animal pal?

Piers the Puffin. (He reminds us to trust the Lord and get on board.)

8. How did the animals get on the Ark?

- A. Noah went around and got them.
- B. Noah made his sons catch them.
- C. Noah blew a horn to round them up.
- D. They came on their own by God's direction.

9. Why did Jesus die on the cross?

Review the gospel. We have each sinned (disobeyed God's commands). We all deserve the punishment for sin, which is death and eternal separation from God's goodness forever. Jesus came to pay the penalty for sin on our behalf by dying on the cross. He was perfect and did not deserve to die, but He died in our place, bearing our sin, so God can forgive our sins, and we can live with Him forever.

10. Is Jesus still dead?

NO! (He rose from the dead and is now and forever alive!)

Review Game Questions and Answers

1. How is Jesus our “Ark of salvation”?

Noah entered the Ark, that God had provided, in order to be saved from God’s watery judgment. When we repent of our sin and believe in Jesus, we can be saved from God’s judgment on our sin.

2. What is today’s lifeline verse?

1 Thessalonians 5:18: “In everything give thanks.”

KJV: “In every thing give thanks.”

3. Fill in the blank: Piers the Puffin reminds us to trust the Lord and get on _____.

Piers the Puffin reminds us to trust the Lord and get on board.

4. What is our animal pal for today?

Paws the Sea Otter. (He reminds us we “otter” thank God.)

5. Yes or No: Noah was the only one who followed God before the Flood.

Yes. (No one else was following God before He sent the Flood. Noah was standing alone.)

6. Are pictures of a “silly Ark” (one that is rounded with little animals sticking out of the windows) really what Noah’s Ark looked like?

No. (The Ark Noah built was a lot sturdier than that! It was six times longer than it was wide, was three decks high, was covered with a roof, and had one window and one door.)

7. Yes or No: The waters prevailed on the earth for 150 days.

Yes.

8. True or False: The Flood waters covered the whole world.

True. (God promised to never send another flood of water to cover the whole world as judgment for sin. We have had local floods, but God has kept His promise and never sent another worldwide flood.)

9. How many people were in Noah’s family?

Noah, his wife, his three sons, and three daughters-in-law. Eight people total.

10. How many of each animal kind came on the Ark?

God brought two of each kind of land-dwelling, air-breathing animals (seven of some).

Pre-Primary Day 5

Review Game Questions and Answers

1. **Who is today's animal pal?**
Fin the Dolphin. (He reminds us "no-fin" is a bigger deal than to fear God.)
2. **What is today's lifeline verse?**
Psalm 112:1: "Blessed is the man who fears the Lord."
KJV: "Blessed is the man that feareth the Lord."
3. **True or False: God said He would never flood the earth again, unless everyone became really bad like they had been when Noah was alive.**
False. (God promised NEVER to judge the entire earth again with water.)
4. **Yes or No: Is it necessary to fear the Lord?**
Yes. (The Bible talks a lot about fearing the Lord—taking Him seriously.)
5. **What was each day's animal pal?**
Hydro the Whale, Hammer the Shark, Piers the Puffin, Paws the Sea Otter, and Fin the Dolphin.
6. **Did anyone besides Noah's family get on the Ark?**
Sadly, no. (The Bible tells us Noah was a preacher of righteousness, but only Noah and his family listened to God and got on the Ark.)
7. **True or False: Everyone will go to heaven, no matter what they do or believe.**
False. (Review the gospel. Only people who fear the Lord and admit [repent of their sins], believe [in Jesus and what He did on the cross], and forever receive Jesus will go to heaven.)
8. **After you become a Christian, can you stop being part of God's family?**
No. (Once you become a child of God, you are forever part of it!)
9. **Does God keep His promises?**
Yes!
10. **What can we remember when we see a rainbow?**
That God always keeps His promises.
