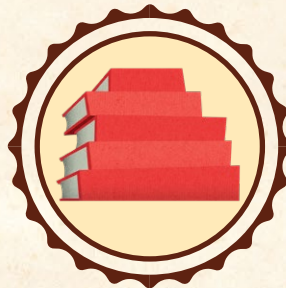

Today, we learned that we all have something in common—even with bad guys like Billy the Kid in the Old West. We all choose to sin (disobey God’s commands). Sin separates us from our holy God. After Adam and Eve disobeyed, every person has sinned and needs a way to have fellowship with God. Jesus paid the penalty for sin when he died on a cross and showed that God accepted his payment when he rose from the dead. What a wonder! You can have fellowship with God and eternal life with him when you admit you are a sinner (repent) and believe Jesus died and rose to life. God will welcome you into his family!

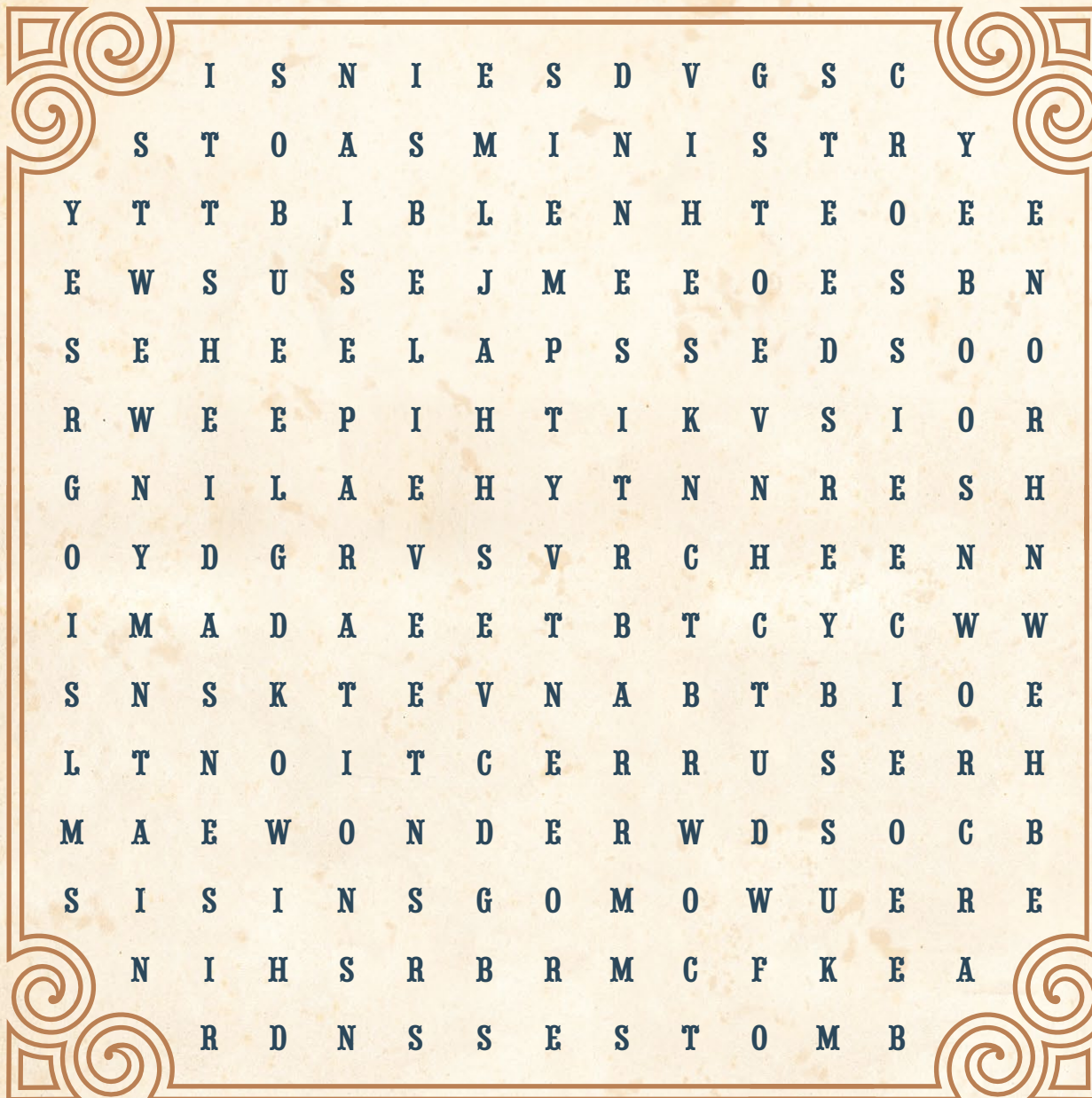
★ How can you fulfill the mission to tell others about Jesus? Make a list of people who need to hear about the
