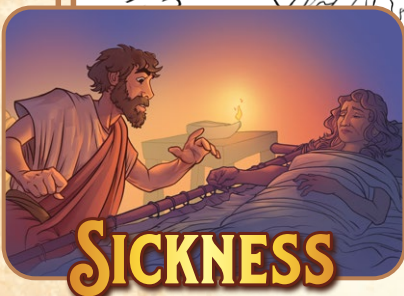

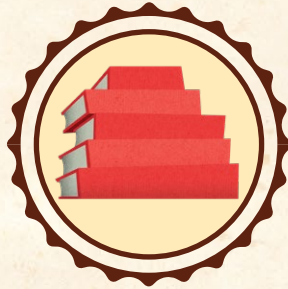

After Adam and Eve disobeyed, every person has sinned and needs a way to have eternal life with God. The Wonder of His Return

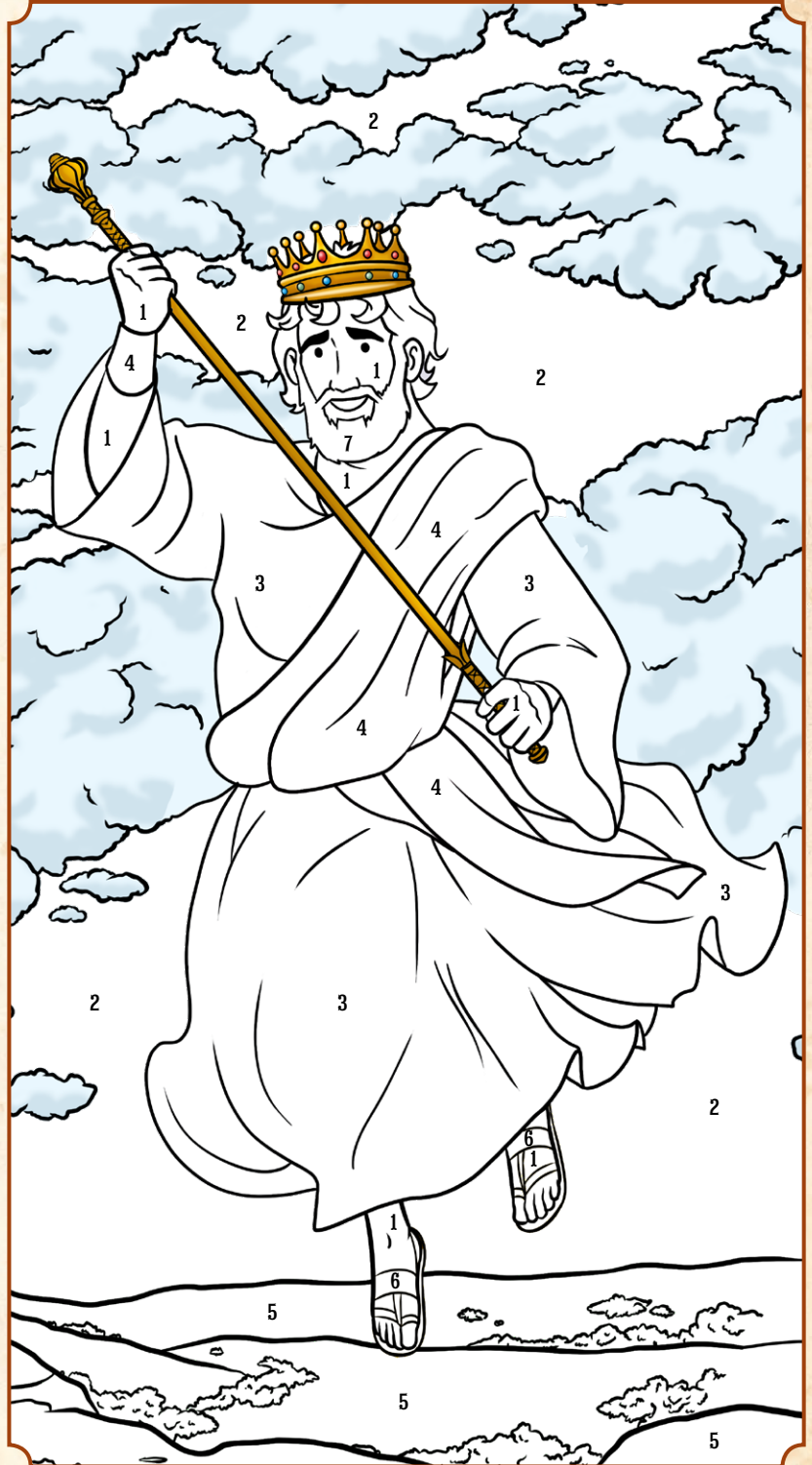
