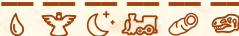



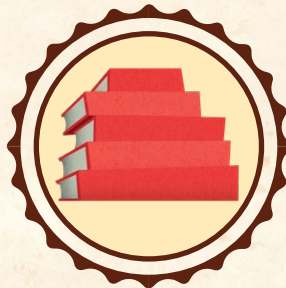

## The Wonder of His Death and Resurrection



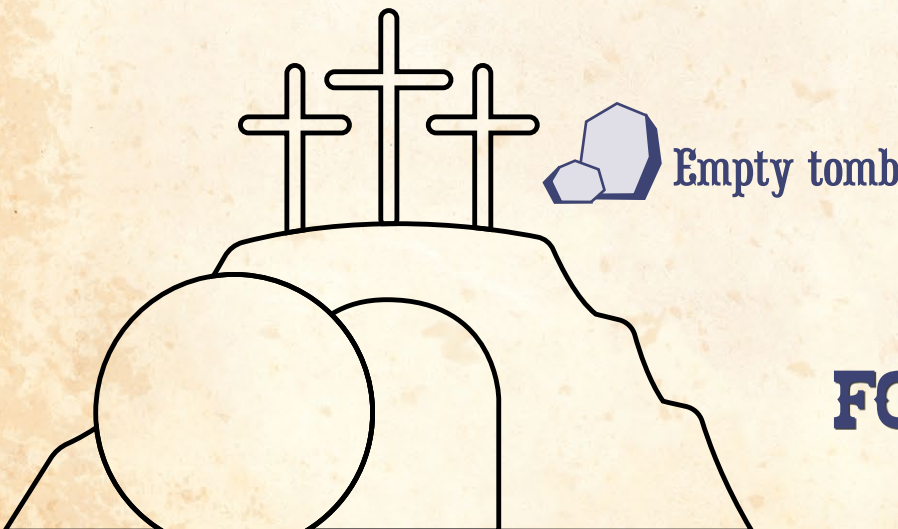

## The Wonder of His Return

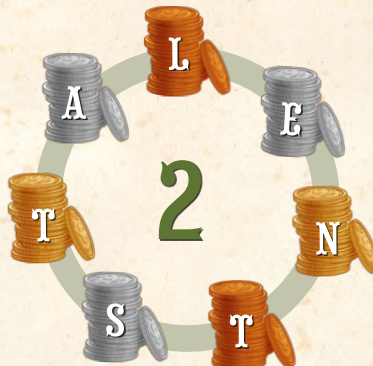
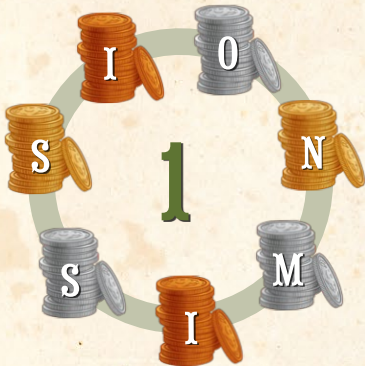

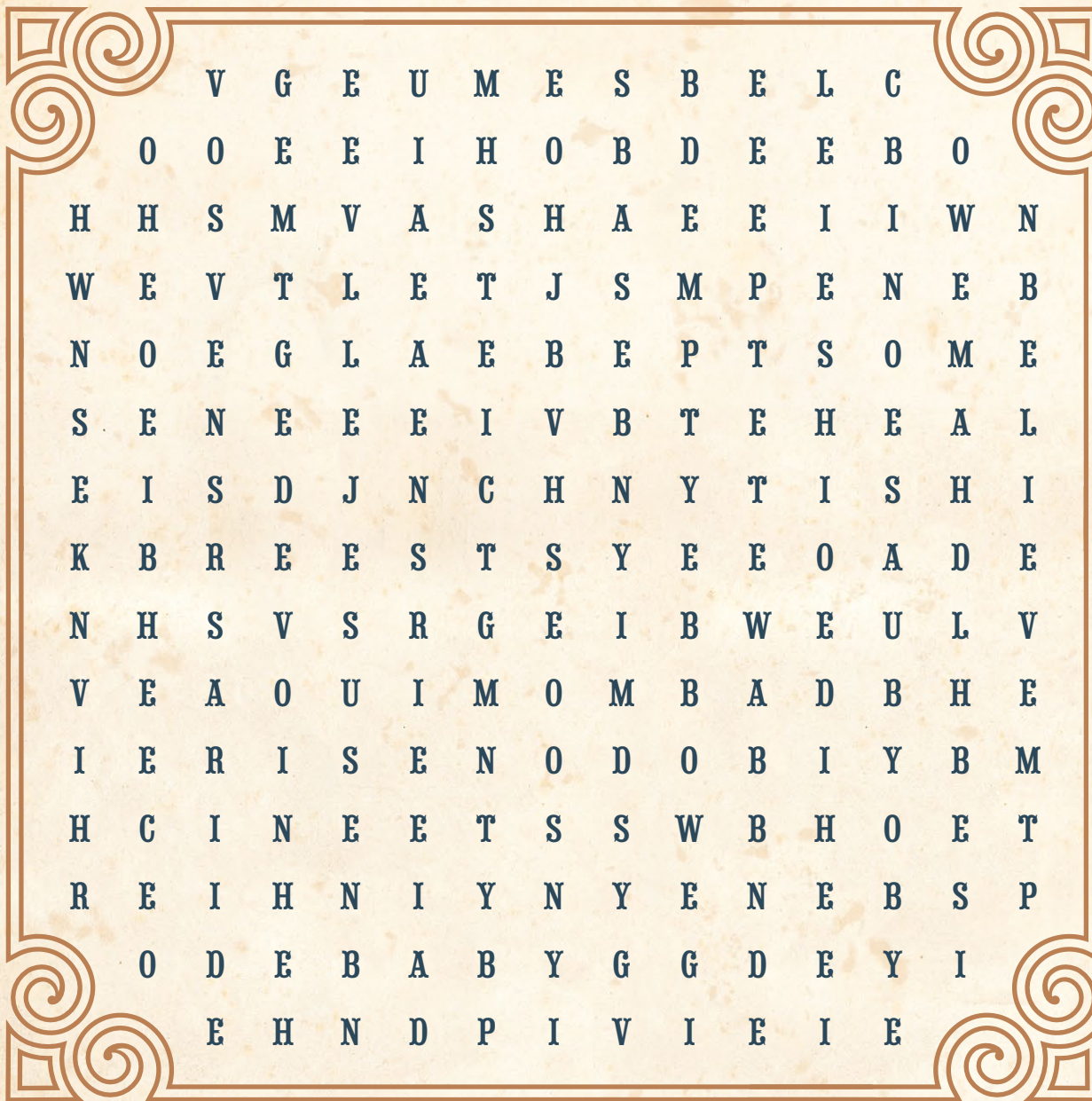


MISSION
