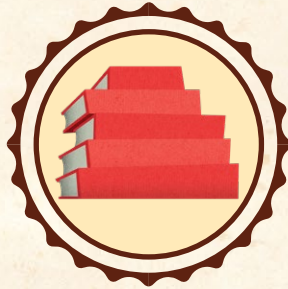


Today's Verse

The Wonder of His Return

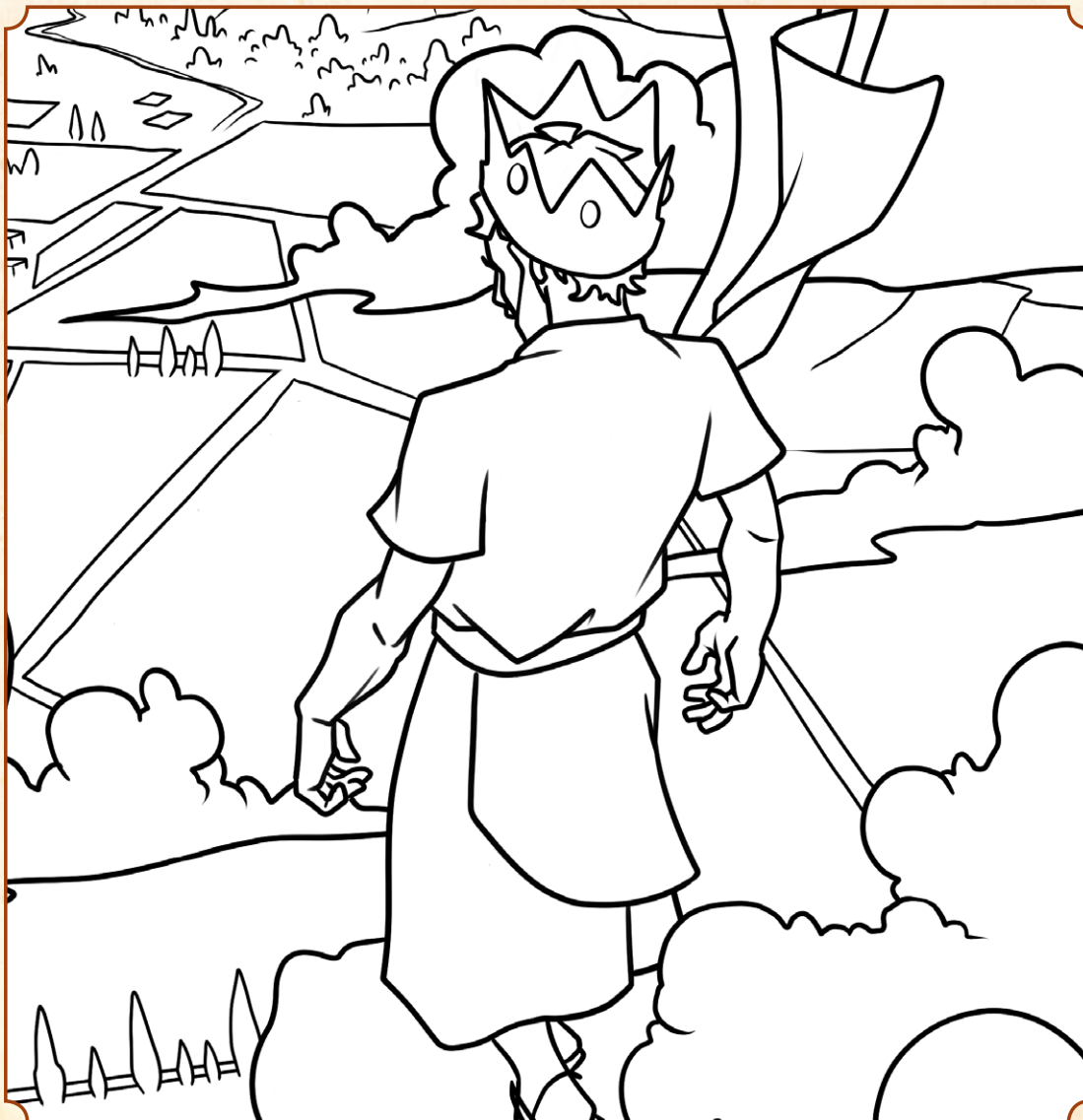
