


A. He made the first two people, Adam and Eve, in his own image. He made Adam from the dust of the ground. He made Eve from Adam's side. He said everything was very good.



Read Genesis 10–11.







Read Romans 5:12-21.








Romans 6:23, 10:9–10; John 17:1–5; 1 John 5:1–13 **Q.** What gift does God offer us?
