VENUS FLYTRAP CARE

INSTRUCTIONS

Pot: Use a plastic or full glazed pot (inside and out) with drainage holes at the bottom. Four inches tall (10 cm) is sufficient for a single flytrap. Larger pots are fine. You'll just need more soil and a larger water dish.

Soil: Use a 50-50 mixture of peat moss and perlite. Do not use MiracleGro products or added fertilizers.

Sunlight: A minimum of four hours direct sunlight is sufficient for a Venus flytrap to subsist. More is better.

Water: Use distilled, collected rain, or reverse osmosis filtered water. Do not use tap water unless it has been tested and has a ppm dissolved solids of 50 or below.

Water dish: This needs to be large enough to allow air space around the pot. This helps to prevent stagnation and allows heat to escape.

Water level: In the pot, water should be $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{3}$ up to the side of the pot at all times during the active growing season. Can be flooded deeper for short durations such as when going on vacation.

A dormant phase is required in the winter where the flytrap prefers lower temperatures and only natural light.

VENUS FLYTRAP CARE

INSTRUCTIONS

Pot: Use a plastic or full glazed pot (inside and out) with drainage holes at the bottom. Four inches tall (10 cm) is sufficient for a single flytrap. Larger pots are fine. You'll just need more soil and a larger water dish.

Soil: Use a 50-50 mixture of peat moss and perlite. Do not use MiracleGro products or added fertilizers.

Sunlight: A minimum of four hours direct sunlight is sufficient for a Venus flytrap to subsist. More is better.

Water: Use distilled, collected rain, or reverse osmosis filtered water. Do not use tap water unless it has been tested and has a ppm dissolved solids of 50 or below.

Water dish: This needs to be large enough to allow air space around the post. This helps to prevent stagnation and allows heat to escape.

Water level: In the pot, water should be $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{3}$ up to the side of the pot at all times during the active growing season. Can be flooded deeper for short durations such as when going on vacation.

A dormant phase is required in the winter where the flytrap prefers lower temperatures and only natural light.




