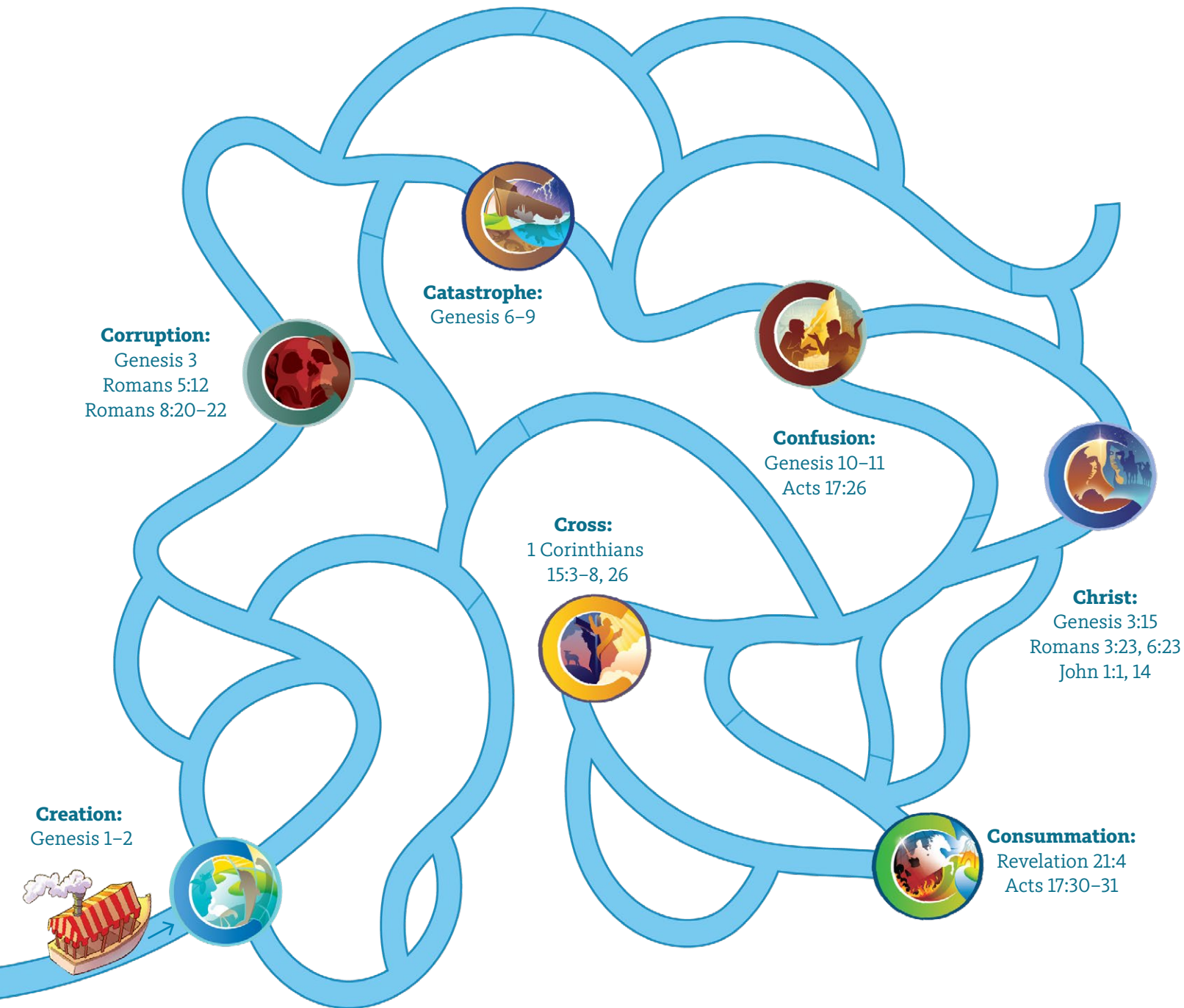

DAY 1: CREATION

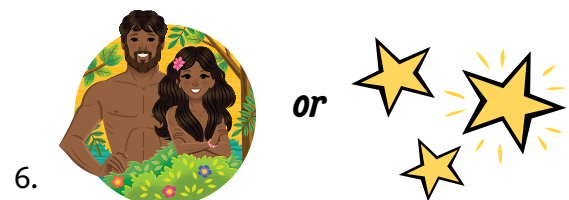
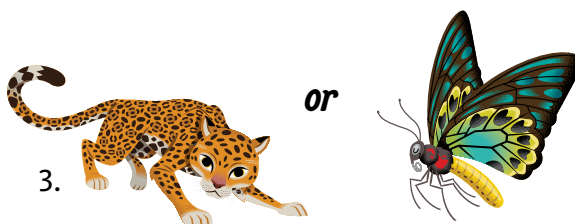
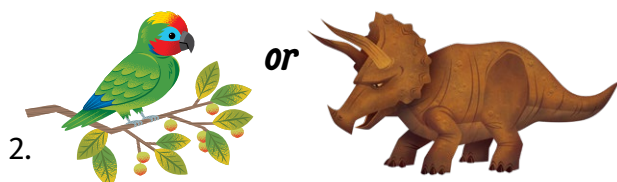
All is Good

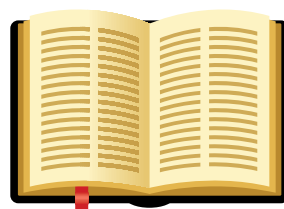


Two things are pictured next to each number below. Circle the one that was created first!

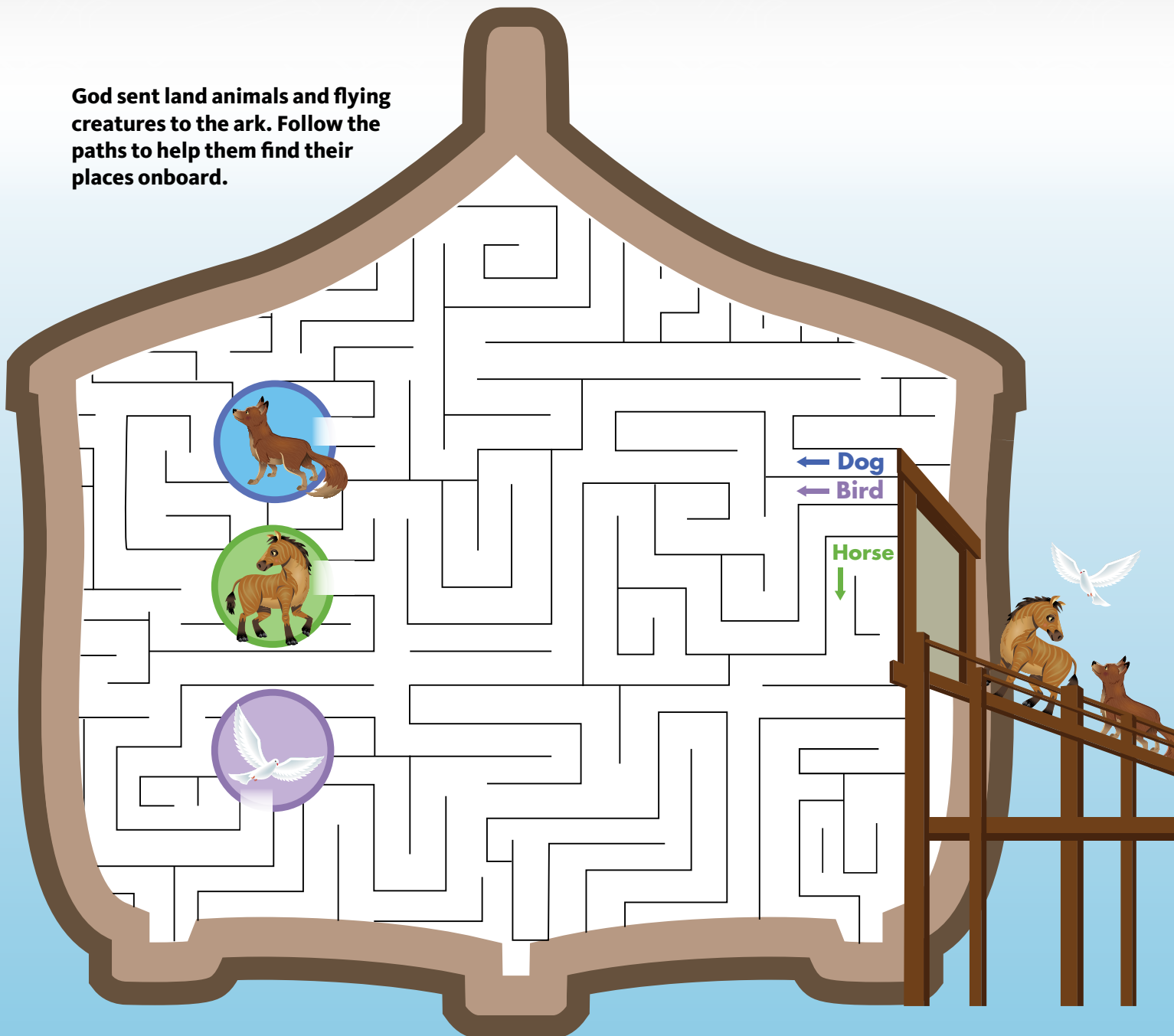
DAY 2: CORRUPTION & CATASTROPHE

Welcome back, travelers! Today on our great jungle journey, we explored some of the dark places in the jungle. First, we learned about the second C, **Corruption**. The Bible tells how Adam and Eve sinned when they disobeyed God by eating fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Since then, the world has been corrupted by sin and has both good and bad in it. Because every person sins, it didn't take long for the corruption to become so bad that God had to judge the people's wickedness by sending a global flood. This is the third C, **Catastrophe**. Water from above and below covered the whole world. Only Noah and his family, along with two of every land-dwelling animal kind (seven of some), were kept safe on the ark.

God sent land animals and flying creatures to the ark. Follow the paths to help them find their places onboard.

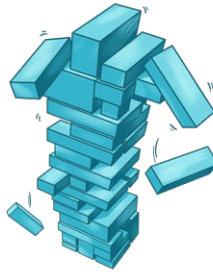

We've already learned that all people sin and our sin separates us from a holy God. The punishment for sin is death and eternal separation from God. Today we saw God's plan to help us with this sin problem. The Bible says that God loves us so much, he sent his perfect Son, Jesus Christ, to earth as a baby. As Jesus grew up, he never sinned, because he is God! But some sinful people nailed Jesus to a cross, and he died. This was all part of God's plan. Jesus took the punishment we deserve for our sins when he died on the cross. But after three days, Jesus came back to life! Now he's in heaven, where all who admit their sin, believe in Jesus, and receive him will be together forever.

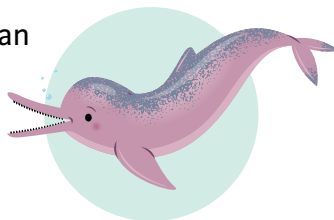
