


COME SAIL THE 7 C'S!

Help our riverboat sail through the 7 C's by completing the maze below.





Day 2: CORRUPTION & CATASTROPHE All Sin

We explored some of the dark places in the jungle. First, we learned about the second C, **Corruption**. The Bible tells how Adam and Eve sinned when they disobeyed God by eating fruit from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Since then, the world has been corrupted by sin and has both good and bad in it. Because every person sins, it didn't take long for the corruption to become so bad that God had to judge the people's wickedness by sending a global flood. This is the third C, **Catastrophe**. Water from above and below covered the whole world. Only Noah and his family, along with two of every land-dwelling animal kind (seven pairs of some), were kept safe on the ark.

God sent land animals and flying creatures to the ark. Follow the paths to help them find their places onboard.

Suddenly, the people couldn't understand each other anymore! So they all left with their families and scattered around the world. That's why there are different people groups who speak in different languages all over the earth. But no matter where we live or what language we speak, we are all part of the same human race!

Do I like to talk about how great I am or how great God is? How can I bring attention to God?



DAY 4: CHRIST & CROSS Savior for All Who Believe

Today we stopped on our jungle journey cruise at two exciting places, the fifth and sixth C's, **Christ** and **Cross**. We've already learned that all people sin and our sin separates us from a holy God. The punishment for sin is death and eternal separation from God. Today we saw God's plan to help us with this sin problem. The Bible says that God loves us so much, he sent his perfect Son, Jesus Christ, to earth as a baby. As Jesus grew up, he never sinned, because he is God! But some sinful people nailed Jesus to a cross, and he died. This was all part of God's plan. Jesus took the punishment we deserve for our sins when he died on the cross. But after three days, Jesus came back to life! Now he's in heaven, where all who admit their sin, believe in Jesus, and receive him will be together forever.

Challenge: Make up actions that go with each section of today's verse. Do them while saying the whole verse.






- Read Revelation 21–22 and think about how the new heaven and new earth will be even more fabulous than we can ever imagine. Will there be new colors? New fruit? New animals?
