





Week 1


**The Belt

Read Ephesians 6 each day this week.

WEEK 1 • DAY 1

Q. Why are we to put on the armor of God?


Ephesians 6:10–13

Ephesians 6:14




A. The belt of truth.

Q. Who is the source of truth?


John 14:6

Psalm 25:10; Titus 1:2




A. Yes.

WEEK 2


**The

Righteousness**

Read Romans 3 each day this week.

WEEK 2 • DAY 1

Q. What is the second piece of armor we are to put on?

Ephesians 6:14



A. The breastplate of righteousness.

Q. How can we be righteous?

**Romans 3:21–22; 2 Corinthians
5:20–21; Philippians 3:8–9**



A. God makes us righteous through faith in Jesus Christ as we believe in Jesus.


Q. How can we know the right things to do?

2 Timothy 3:15–16

A. We need to read and study the Scriptures (the Bible), which tells us what is right.

Q. Who helps us make right choices?

Philippians 1:8-11



A. Jesus helps us do the right thing to the glory of God.

Q. Will it always be easy to do the right thing?

1 Peter 3:13–17

*A. No. Sometimes we may need to suffer for doing what is right.
But we are blessed when we suffer for righteousness' sake.*



WEEK 3


**The Shoes
of Peace**

Read Galatians 5 each day this week.

WEEK 3 • DAY 1

Q. What is the third piece of armor we are to put on?

Ephesians 6:15



A. The shoes of the gospel of peace.


Q. What is the gospel of peace?

Romans 5:1–2

*A. When we repent of our sins and believe in Jesus
("justified by faith"), we have peace with God.*

Q. Who gives us peace?

Psalm 29:11



A. The Lord gives peace to his people.

Q. How can we have peace even
in difficult circumstances?

Psalm 119:165; Isaiah 26:3; Philippians 4:6-7

*A. When we love God and his Word and follow
his commands, we will have peace.*

Q. Why should we tell others
about the gospel of peace?

Romans 10:14–15

*A. So that they can repent of their sins and believe
in Jesus and have peace with God.*



WEEK 4


**The Shield
of Faith**

**Read Hebrews 11 each
day this week.**

WEEK 4 • DAY 1

Q. What is the fourth piece of armor we are to put on?

Ephesians 6:16



A. The shield of faith.

Q. What is faith?

Hebrews 11:1

A. Faith is trusting in God even though we can't see him.

WEEK 4 • DAY 3


Q. Who are we to have faith in?

Galatians 2:15–16, 2:20; 1 Corinthians 15:1–8

A. We are to have faith in Jesus Christ and believe that he died and rose from the dead three days later.

Q. Is God always worthy of our faith?

Psalm 119:90



A. Yes! God is always faithful and worthy of our trust.

Q. Is the Bible worthy of our faith?

Psalm 119:138

A. Yes! God's testimonies (his Word, the Bible) are true and faithful, and we can trust it.




WEEK 5

**The Helmet
of Salvation**

Read Ephesians 2 each day this week.

Q. What is the fifth piece of armor we are to put on?


Ephesians 6:17



A. The helmet of salvation.

Q. Why do we need to be saved?

Romans 3:21–23, 6:23



A. Because we are sinners who need to confess our sins (repent) and believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead on our behalf.

Q. How do we receive the gift of salvation?

Acts 3:19; Romans 10:8-10

A. We need to confess our sins (repent) and believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead on our behalf.

Q. Is there anyone else besides Jesus who we can trust to save us from our sins?

Acts 4:8–12

A. No. Jesus is the only one who we can trust to save us!

Q. How can we show God we're thankful for our salvation?

Psalm 96:2

*A. We can praise God and thank him for saving us
and tell others about how he has saved us.*



WEEK 6

**The Sword of
the Spirit**

Read Psalm 119 this week.

Q. What is the sixth piece of armor we are to put on?

Ephesians 6:17


Q. How did Jesus respond
when Satan tempted him?

Matthew 4:1–11

A. He quoted Bible verses to show Satan where he was wrong.

Q. What does Jesus say about those who study God's Word and obey it?

Luke 11:28



A. They are blessed.

Q. Why is it important to know
and memorize God's Word?


Psalm 119:9-11

*A. So that we can obey his commands and live a
life that is pure and pleasing to God.*

WEEK 6 • DAY 5

Q. How can we show God that we love him?

John 14:15; 1 John 2:5



A. By obeying his commands in the Bible.



WEEK 7


Prayer

Read Psalm 54 each day this week.

WEEK 7 • DAY 1

Q. What else are we to do so that
we can be strong in the Lord?

Ephesians 6:18



A. Pray.

Q. Who do we pray to?

Nehemiah 1:5; Psalm 5:2; Matthew 6:9

A. We pray to the one true God, the Lord of heaven and earth.

Q. What should we pray for?

Matthew 5:44, 6:5–15; Philippians 4:6

A. We can pray for our enemies, that the Lord's will be done, that God will provide our needs, that he will forgive us our sins, that he will deliver us from the evil one, and that he will be glorified in our lives.

Q. When should we pray?

Psalm 55:17; 1 Thessalonians 5:16–18

A. Evening, morning, midday—all day long, we can talk to God!

Q. Does God hear our prayers?

**Psalm 6:9, 65:2, 66:17–20; Proverbs
15:29; 1 John 5:14–15**

*A. Yes! God hears the prayers of those who love him.
And he answers according to his will.*
