
The Breastplate of Righteousness

Read Romans 3 each day this week.






A. God makes us righteous through faith in Jesus Christ as we believe in Jesus.




Q. Who helps us make right choices? Philippians 1:8-11


A. Jesus helps us do the right thing to the glory of God.

Q. What is the gospel of peace? **Romans 5:1-2** ("Justified by faith"), we have peace with God.




Q. What is the fourth piece of armor we are to put on? **Ephesians 6:16**

Q. Who are we to have faith in? Galatians 2:15-16, 2:20; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8


> A. We are to have faith in Jesus Christ and believe that he died and rose from the dead three days later.

Q. What is the fifth piece of armor we are to put on? **Ephesians 6:17**


Q. Why do we need to be saved? Romans 3:21-23, 6:23

Jesus died and rose from the dead on our behalf.


