Were Dinosaurs Dragons?

Some dragons flew and other dragons lived in the water, so not all dragons could be called dinosaurs because dinosaurs lived on the land. But all dinosaurs could have been dragons.

Cultures from all over the globe have dragon legends. The descriptions of these beasts are often very similar to those of dinosaurs.
