








The Breastplate & Shoes




The Shield & Helmet

CHALLENGE: Practice the verse several times while pretending to take up the shield and put on the helmet.






The Sword & Prayer


CHALLENGE: Act out today's verse as you say it. Then see if you can go the whole way through the verses, putting on the whole armor of God.






Go and Do 🖂👀
