

The Two Kingdoms








Go and Do




The Sword & Prayer

Draw a line from the armor on the left to its match on the right. Color the pictures.




CHALLENGE: Act out today's verse as you say it. Then see if you can go the whole way through the verses, putting on the whole armor of God.
