NOTES

RESORT INFORMATION BOARD AND EASEL

Create an information board out of foam board or corrugated cardboard. Use it to list resort activities and/or beach conditions. Place it on a large easel that can easily collapse or fall when bumped. Consider it to be a permanent part of the set.

MISS MABRY'S "O" NECKLACE

Make a simple necklace using three washers (small, medium, and large) and some leather cording. Color the washers with sharpies, then hot glue them together in pyramid fashion with the largest on the bottom, then the medium, then the smallest on top.

TREASURE MAP

Make an authentic looking treasure map with a large piece of white roll paper. Tear away the straight edges, then crumple it up, smooth it out, and soak it in coffee or tea water. Then hang it up to dry.
