

Day 1: Small Group Time

Discuss some or all of the following questions from the discussion sheet. Any day a Bible passage is mentioned, help them look it up and read it together, or have it bookmarked and read it to them.

1. **When we asked what comes into your mind when you think of God, what did you think of?** Take responses.
2. **How do you think you got that idea about God?** Take responses. **Where should we go to learn about who God really is?** Take responses and remind them we can't make God into who we want him to be, but we learn who he truly is from the Bible.
3. **Who is someone famous you would be super excited to get to know?** Take responses.
4. **Does God seem exciting to you? More exciting than that person in Question 3? Worth knowing?** Take responses and tell them how excited you are to share more this week about your awesome God. You may want to share your testimony here and the gospel. Your enthusiasm about God will be inspiring.
5. **What is something you've learned about God so far today?** Take responses.

Day 3: Small Group Time

Discuss some or all of the following questions.

1. Can you think of any books or movies you've seen with a king sitting on a throne, wearing a robe? What do you picture God's robe to look like that's mentioned in Isaiah?
2. What's something about God you're amazed about today?
3. Do you ever sing songs to God? Do you like to? The Bible tells us to sing our praises to God. Do you have any favorite songs you like to sing to God?
4. Let's try something nicknamed popcorn prayers, which are one-sentence prayers that "pop up" around the circle. Someone starts and praises God for something, like, "I praise you, God, for being loving." Then another person says one thing he praises God for, and another person says something she praises God for, and on and on.
5. Can you think of someone to whom you can tell something amazing about God? Do it today!

Discuss some or all of the following questions.

1. Do you like to watch or read mysteries? Which ones? Have you ever read or watched a mystery where they were trying to figure out who the guilty person was?
2. In today's lesson, did it surprise you to have to put yourself in the line-up of people who are guilty of sin? Do you understand why that's true?
3. Have you ever considered just how amazing it is that the wonderful, loving God came to earth for sinners like you, to rescue you from sin's punishment? Do you understand that you have to trust in Jesus to be rescued?
4. Have you ever admitted your sin to God, believed in Jesus, and forever received him as your Lord and Savior? Can you tell us about it? Take kids' testimonies here, or share your own.
