**When we take a good look** at what the Bible teaches about Jesus, we will discover that he has existed from eternity past and will exist into eternity future. Jesus is eternal. He is God and has no beginning and will have no ending!


**Creation:** Jesus is the Creator of all things, including time itself (Genesis 1:1, John 1:1–3, Colossians 1:16–17). Even before he created all things and before Adam and Eve disobeyed him (sinned), he had a plan to rescue his people and provide eternal life to them.

**Christophany:** Since the beginning, Jesus has appeared throughout time to various people. He was known as the Angel of the Lord when he appeared before he came to earth as a baby. Check out these passages that refer to Jesus: Genesis 18, Exodus 3, Exodus 14:19, Judges 6. He gave promises (prophecies) about the time when he would come to earth, too.

**Cross:** About 2,000 years ago, Jesus came to earth. He lived a perfect life and never sinned (check out the Gospels). He always obeyed God. Jesus died on the Cross to take the punishment for sin and rose three days later (Matthew 27–28). When we repent of (turn from) our sins and believe that Jesus paid the penalty for our sins, we can receive the gift of eternal life (Acts 16:31).

**Clouds:** After he rose from the dead, Jesus was taken up into heaven through the clouds (Acts 1). Since that time, he has been building his church, interceding for his children, and preparing a place for those who love him (Matthew 16:18, John 14:2–3, Romans 8:34, Hebrews 7:25, 1 John 2:1).

**Crown:** Jesus is the forever King of all kings. Those who have received the gift of eternal life look forward to spending forever with God in the new heaven and new earth, where there are streets of gold (Revelation 21) and where there is only goodness because Jesus is there!
