Timer for leader (smartphone timer can work)

Fling the Sling

Cones or masking tape for start line

Tube socks (long/calf-length), 1 for every 4 children

Tennis balls, 1 for every 4 children

Stuffed bear or lion

Roman Ball

Rubber ball (tennis ball, rubber baseball, or a small playground ball that's well inflated)

Buckets of water, 1 per team

Target, 1 per team

Poster board clouds, 5 per team

Tag, Tag, and More Tag

4 cones

Several hula hoops

Several sponges and a bucket of water

Day 5

So Many Rooms

4 cones

Paper plates OR plastic flat lids that are at least 4 inches across, 4 per child

4 small kiddie pools

1 small ball for every 2 children

Crowns

4 cones

Sponge balls or sponges, 1 for every 2 players

4-6 buckets or kiddie pools filled with water

Crowns, at least 5 per child (optional pattern inside the front cover)

2 rectangular tables

10 plastic cups to stack into a pyramid

Large squirt gun ("water cannon")
