

**DAY 1: WONDER NUGGET 1**

**DAY 2: WONDER NUGGET 1**

**DAY 1: WONDER NUGGET 3**

Jesus didn't become a king. He already was a king when he was born. Wow!

**DAY 2: WONDER NUGGET 3**

Jesus always does the right thing—always! Never has he ever done even one thing wrong.

**DAY 1: WONDER NUGGET 4**

Jesus knows absolutely everything. For example, he knows how many hairs are on each person's head right now. If one falls out of your head (or someone's head on the other side of the world), he knows it.

**DAY 2: WONDER NUGGET 4**

Wonder what Jesus' favorite toy was? Did he play sports? Did he have neighborhood friends?

**DAY 1: WONDER NUGGET 5**

Jesus knows every baby that will be born today in the world . . . and every baby born tomorrow, and five years from now, and on and on. He even knows the kids you may have some day!

**DAY 2: WONDER NUGGET 5**

Jesus made the universe, then he came and lived in the universe he made.

**DAY 3: WONDER NUGGET 1**

Jesus was born in a small town to a mother and earthly father who was a carpenter. His grown-up ministry took place in an area no bigger than the state of Arkansas. And yet, look at the impact he has had on the world!

**DAY 4: WONDER NUGGET 1**

God died for sinners like you. And then he rose from the dead.

**DAY 3: WONDER NUGGET 2**

The wonders we read about in the Bible aren't the only wonders Jesus did. His wonders are beyond number, and they're also beyond words. We try to come up with words—awesome, amazing, wonderful. But there are no words that come close to describing all that he has done.

**DAY 4: WONDER NUGGET 2**

When Jesus died, the sun didn't shine. When Jesus died, the earth shook. It was as if his creation was sad and grieving.

**DAY 3: WONDER NUGGET 3**

More books have been written about Jesus than anyone else, as have been songs.

**DAY 4: WONDER NUGGET 3**

Here's one of the biggest thoughts ever: Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so.

**DAY 3: WONDER NUGGET 4**

Take a deep breath. Jesus is the one who just gave you that breath—and every other breath.

**DAY 4: WONDER NUGGET 4**

There was no other birth like Jesus', and there was no other death like his, either. His death paid the penalty for sin. No one else's death has paid for sin.

**DAY 3: WONDER NUGGET 5**

Nature obeys Jesus! For example, Jesus calmed the sea with just a word. Who else can do that?

**DAY 4: WONDER NUGGET 5**

Dying wasn't easy for Jesus. Before he went to the cross, he sweated drops of blood (Luke 22:44). That's how great his love is for you.

**DAY 5: WONDER NUGGET 1**

Jesus is now in heaven ruling the universe—what a wonder! He is also interceding for us—he’s telling God our every need (Hebrews 7:25). The one who is ruling the universe is also talking to God about you if you are his child. He’s aware of your every need every second, and he takes your prayers and needs to God. Wow!

**DAY 5: WONDER NUGGET 4**

The creator of the world stepped into his creation as a baby at just the right time (Galatians 4:4). Then the creator returned to heaven after he fulfilled his mission of providing a way of salvation for all those who repent and believe in him.

**DAY 5: WONDER NUGGET 2**
