

God's special book, the Bible, tells us in Genesis 1 and 2 that God created the world and everything in it in six days. During those six days, God made the light, the sky, the sea, the dry land, the plants, the sun, the moon, the stars, the fish, the birds, and the animals. And it was all good. God wasn't finished yet, though! God made a very special creation in his image—people!

Have I thanked God for making me just the way I am?



Made with Amazing Design



Try the Challenge again, this time saying tomorrow's verse.




